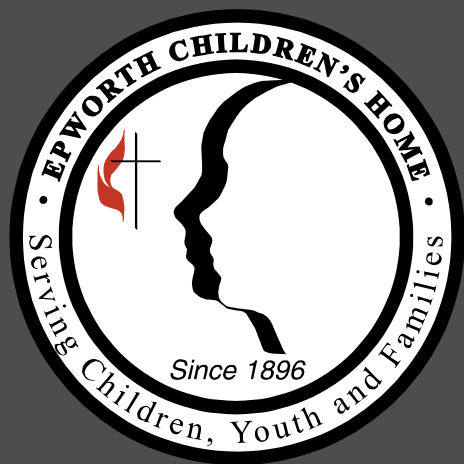

## Volunteer Opportunities with Children

- **Mentors\*\*Most needed: Male Mentors!\*\***  
Individuals matched to an individual child to enrich his or her life through regular activities, visits and outings. *Commitment: 1 year and 4 contact hours per month.*
- **Cottage Partners**  
Groups (church and civic groups, businesses, etc) matched to an entire cottage of children. Events and visits may be scheduled at the comfort and frequency level of the Cottage Partner. *Commitment: At least 3 contacts per year.*
- **Faith Formation Leaders**  
Groups or individuals that assist with worship, teach and lead Sunday School, bible study, and youth group activities. *Commitment: 1 year (school year) or one session.*

## Campus Volunteer Opportunities

- **Campus Projects**  
Minor building repairs and remodels, Landscape & campus beautification, Cottage/campus caretakers, Administrative support.
- **Activities and Events**  
One-time campus-wide events, One-time cottage(s) activity, Off-campus events, Fundraising events.
- **Missions at Epworth**  
Faith-based mission "trips" for groups, Single & Multiple-day service projects, Hands-on projects, Fully funded by volunteers.
