Residential Care

Epworth Children's Home's residential care program serves children ages 12-18 in ten cottages at Epworth's historic campus on Millwood Avenue in Columbia. In 2020, the residential program served 125 children and provided 16,311 days of care.

The Early Intervention Center*

The Epworth Early Intervention Center serves families with children who have special needs, developmental delays, and/or disabilities. The EEIC includes a preschool, home-based early intervention services and cooperative respite care.



The Center for Counseling*

The Epworth Center for Counseling provides counseling to children and youth, their families, and adults. Treatment begins with meeting one of our licensed therapists for an evaluation that will result in recommendations for services. Our goal is to move one towards a life of positive health and happiness. Community referrals welcomed!

The Center for Independent Living*

Epworth provides services to pursue Higher Education and/or career readiness for young people ages 18-23 who are "aging out" of foster care. The program prepares young people for transition into the adult world in a safe and supportive community.

The Center for Family Engagement*

Epworth's Foster Care Program recruits and licenses qualified foster families for children ages 0-21. Foster families receive the training and resources needed to provide the same level of transformational care Epworth provides in its residential program.

The Family Care Center*

The Family Care Center is a unique program for mothers with substance abuse difficulties and their children. The family lives together at Epworth while the mother receives addiction treatment. Epworth teaches parenting skills while providing care for the children and nurturing family bonds.



The Center for Family Empowerment*

Circle of Parents®

Epworth is the state partner to Circle of Parents®, a national organization that provides training and technical support for the development of parent-driven support groups with a parallel children's program called Children's Circle. These parent groups are peer led, mutual self-help groups for all parents.

The Center for Family Empowerment*

HOMEBUILDERS®

HOMEBUILDERS® provides intensive, in-home crisis intervention, counseling and life-skills education for families with children from birth to age 18 who are at imminent risk of placement in state-funded care. The goal of HOMEBUILDERS® is to prevent the unnecessary out-of-home placement of children through intensive, on-site intervention, and to teach families new problem-solving skills to prevent future crises.
