Residential Care

Epworth's residential care program serves youth ages 12-18 in family style cottages on the historic Epworth campus on Millwood Avenue in Columbia. Residents receive 24-7 adult support, mental health counseling, academic tutoring, healthcare, and other assistance.

Foster Care

Epworth's Foster Care Program recruits and licenses single individuals and married couples statewide to provide care for children ranging in age from birth to 21. Foster parents receive the training and resources needed to provide the same level of transformational care Epworth provides in its residential program. Epworth maintains foster care staff in all six regions statewide to ensure parents get 24-7 support. Staff act as advocates, sounding boards, resource locators, advisors, and connectors.

Kinship Care

For relatives and fictive kin caring for another person's child, this program provides advocacy, case management, resources, and training to help kinship caregivers access legal, financial and other kinds of support.

Early Intervention Center

The Epworth Early Intervention Center serves families with children who have special needs, developmental delays, and/or disabilities. The EEIC includes a preschool, home-based early intervention services and cooperative respite care.

Family Care Center

The Family Care Center is a unique program for mothers with substance abuse difficulties and their children. The family lives together at Epworth while the mother receives addiction treatment, parenting and life skills classes.



Transitional Care

Epworth provides services to pursue higher education and/or career readiness for young people ages 18-23 who are "aging out" of foster care. The program prepares young people for transition into the adult world in a safe and supportive community.

Center for Counseling

The Epworth Center for Counseling is an outpatient counseling center for children, teens, families, and individual adults. The licensed and well-trained therapists specialize in treating a variety of mental, behavioral, and substance use concerns.

Circle of Parents®

Epworth is the state partner to Circle of Parents®, a national organization that provides training and technical support for the development of parent-led support groups.

Family Resource Connection and Preservation

(2-6 months)

This program helps families meet short-term or immediate needs, increases child safety, and strengthens family stability through parenting education, skill building, case management, and help obtaining resources.

HOMEBUILDERS®

(4-6 weeks)

Counsels and works closely with families who are at imminent risk of a child being placed in care. For 4-6 weeks, staff meet with families to provide counseling, life-skills education, and problem-solving and communication skills.
