Sunday, May 3rd, 2026

For children who have been removed from their homes because of abuse or neglect and placed in the residential program or in foster care with Epworth, Mother's Day can be an emotional day for them. It is our role as Christians to make sure that children served by Epworth know that they are loved on Mother's Day and every day. We can do that by supporting the Annual Mother's Day Offering that will be received next Sunday. Our contributions help Epworth to provide the services necessary to improve the lives of the children and the families they serve across the state. We can be proud of our support for Epworth. In recent years, Epworth has expanded their programming to support the increasingly high numbers of children, youth and families who need their services. Our support is essential in helping them show the love of Christ in action. So next Sunday, on Mother's Day, please prayerfully consider the children and families whose lives are impacted daily because of Epworth.

Epworth Children's Home was founded in 1896, with a mission of serving children whose families could not care for them. In 2025, 2,230 children, youth, and families were served because they had experienced some form of trauma. After 130 years, the mission remains the same: to serve children, youth and families through caring, safe, Christian communities, where hurts are healed, hope is nurtured and faith in God, self and others is developed. Epworth ensures the children are surrounded by loving Christian adults who work hard to create a warm, friendly and welcoming environment so that the children feel safe. Only then can they learn to break the cycle of abuse, neglect, and shame and replace it with a life of self-respect, responsibility, and productivity.

How does Epworth do this work? Because of our generosity. Epworth relies heavily on the contributions received through the Mother's Day offering to provide direct care for the children who live on campus, those in foster and kinship care and the children and families receiving care and support through Epworth's variety of programs across our state.
